

Market Research

The Market Research tool available in MarketMaker is very valuable for both new and existing businesses. New businesses can use it to research potential markets and existing businesses can use it to research their current market for changing trends.

- 1. Open the Mississippi MarketMaker home page and locate the Market Research tab on the Left hand side of the page
- 2. Click the first drop down tab and select 'Food Preferences'.
- 3. Select "Average Fruits and Vegetables at Home" in the Subtype dropdown menu and select the Search tab.
- 4. A map of the results will be displayed along with a chart showing the data. You may then select a different state or county. For this example, Harrison County was used.
